Department of Computer Application, St. Thomas College, Palai and Logic Software Solutions Private Limited

This MoU valid from 3rd April 2019 to 30th March 2020 was to provide technical assistance to the students of BCA in Python Language. The areas of cooperation included training in corresponding technology, assisting students in practical tests and assessment of students' skills after the course. The duration of the course was seventy hours on all Saturdays.

The Python training consisted of two phases. The students were given a theory and practical session in the selected platform during the initial phase. The second phase included project design and development.

St. Thomas College, Palai and National Centre for Earth Science Studies

This MoU between St. Thomas College, Palai and National Centre for Earth Science Studies was intended to install lightning detection devices in the premises of the college and to encourage mutual research assistance and faculty exchange. The activities also included exchange of collaborative research programs in the area of Lightning with the faculty of Physics Department of the College. The NCESS also promised to promote internship or dissertation work of qualified undergraduate or graduate students of the Department.



10 St. Thomas College, Palai and Alphonso College, Palai

This MoU is between St. Thomas College, Palai and Alphonso College, Palai regarding the newly built Sports Complex. The agreement clearly states that the parties involved should adhere to the rules and regulations regarding the use and maintenance of the Complex. In the wake of any activity or repair the MoU states that the athletes will be restrained. The regulations regarding the use of the swimming pool and the badminton court are vividly stated in the agreement between the two parties. Anyone other than the bonafide students of the second party is not entitled to avail the facilities of the Complex. It is valid up to twenty-five years.

11 St. Thomas College, Palai and T.I.M.E Kottayam

This MoU is regarding management entrance test preparation for second year UG students of St. Thomas College, Palai. The total course duration including sectional and mock tests is 114 hours. This includes training for group discussion and personal interview. A 'course completed' certificate will be issued to the students after the completion of the course. The venue and classroom facilities will be provided by the College. The coaching programme also includes study materials, mock tests and practice for group discussion and personal interview.



12 St. Thomas College, Palai and Vcode Infotech India Private Limited

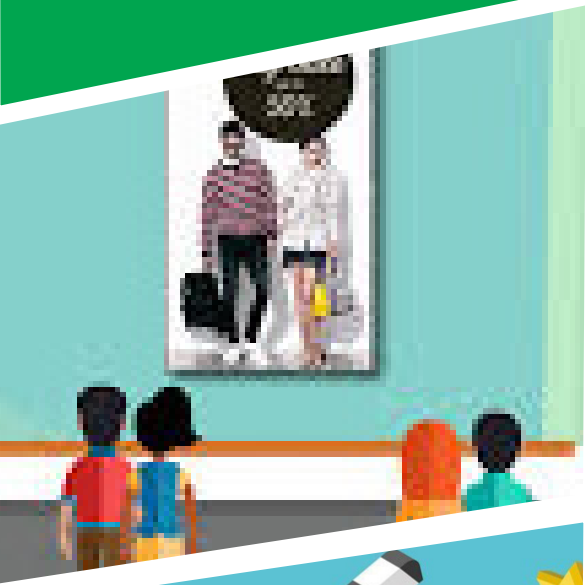

The MoU makes clear that any service that exceeds the contract will have to be paid additionally. The agreement vividly states that the Contractor, ie, Vcode Infotech India Private Limited will make genuine efforts to make the client website safe and live, but does not warrant that the hosted website will be hack free or that the operation of the pages will be uninterrupted.



13 St. Thomas College, Palai and Netsmith Info Solutions Private Limited

This MoU regarding office automation was reached on 25th September 2016 between M/S Netsmith Info Solutions Private Limited and St. Thomas College, Palai, for a period of five years. The services offered include uploading of students' details, alumni login, admission, class tests, assignments, attendance, library automation, automation of finance section, management of staff portal etc. The agreement makes clear that the Vendor shall provide service from 9.00 am to 6.00 pm on all working days to keep the system in good working order which may include necessary repair and fitting of parts. The MoU also warns against the redistribution or alteration of the software by the Customer.





14 St. Thomas College, Palai and Amlire Private Limited, Kakkanad

This MoU is regarding the setting up of internet TV channel in the College's Canteen. The agreement was for a period of nine months from 5th July 2018. The Understanding vividly states that the student's internet TV channel will be run as per the Canteen timings and that the technical aspect of such display will be the responsibility of Amlire Private Limited. The channel provided University/ educational news and updates, motivation programmes, travel documentary, international news, youth education, fest and national seminar details, government programmes, start- up kits for students' entrepreneurship promotion, intentional organisations campaigns, latest news concerning automotive industry etc. The MoU also clarifies that the ads displayed will not have contents related to religious orientations, political news, advertisements of alcohol, tobacco, pan masala, other government banned products, college banned items or demeaning images. The Second party also agrees that the ads will not be displayed without an email approval from the First party i.e., St. Thomas College, Palai.
