Analysis Report on Students' Feedback 2017 – 2018 on Syllabus and its Transaction at the Institution

The student feedback was an attempt by the institution to scrutinise the efficacy of syllabus transaction and the overall efficiency of the teaching-learning process. More than ninety percentage of the students strongly agreed to the fact of the syllabus being explained at the beginning of the course. Regarding the capability of the syllabus in meeting global and industrial needs, about half of the respondents were reserved. Only below ten percentage of the students were dissatisfied with the institutional practice of explaining the grading criteria of the course by the teachers. More than four fifth of the students agreed to the fact that assignments were related to the syllabus of the course. More than three quarters of the students agreed that the syllabus was timely completed while the rest of them were doubtful about it.

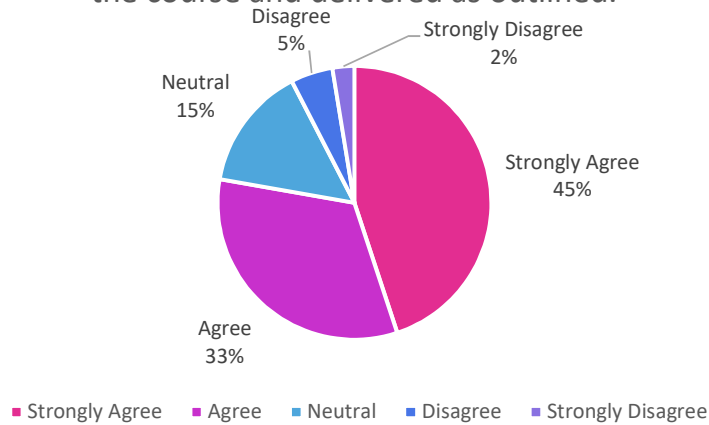

Analysis Report on Student's Feedback 2017 – 2018 on General Aspects of the Institution

The latter part of the feedback consisting of ten questions was intended to measure the efficiency of course outcome in correspondence with student satisfaction. While about ninety percentage of the students expressed their satisfaction with the internal examination mechanism, the remaining students did not agree with it. Regarding the transparency of the evaluation system most of the students answered in the affirmative. Concerning the maintenance of labs and classroom, about seventeen percentage of the students registered their disagreement.

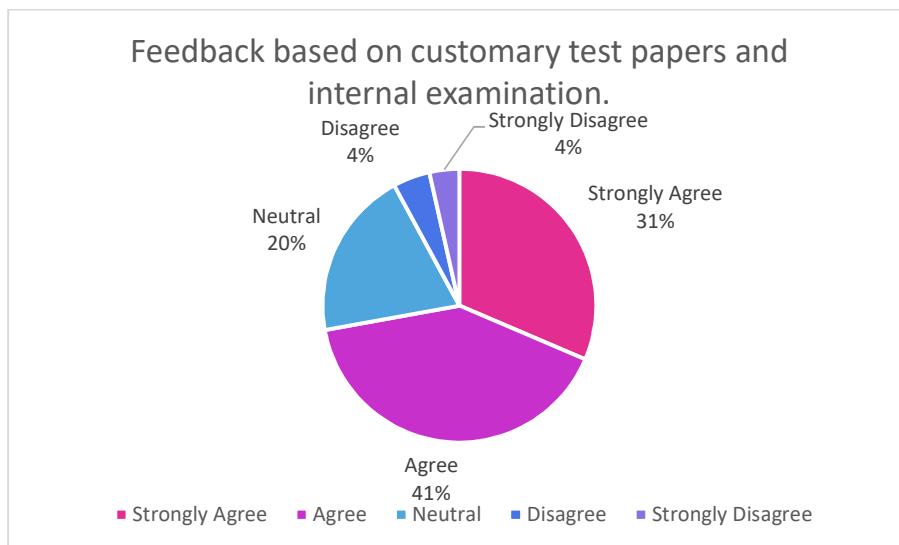
Most of the students expressed their apprehension regarding the timely completion of examination and declaration of results by the University. A total of ninety percentage of the students were satisfied with the learning resources provided by the institution.

The feedback showed that the students were not very much satisfied with extracurricular activities in the institution. Not many students expressed their unhappiness about the infrastructural facilities of the institution. Around seventy- one percentage of the students were happy about the service rendered by the administrative and library staff. Most of the students had no disagreement that the college was an eco- friendly one while the respondents had a low opinion of the institutions capability in inculcating values like sustainable development and eco-consciousness.
