Analysis Report on Alumni Feedback 2018–2019 on Syllabus and its Transaction at the Institution

Alumni feedback on syllabus encompasses a wide range of dimensions of the syllabus ranging from its employability potential to clearing competitive examinations. The feedback on syllabus focused on five thrust areas. The employability of the syllabus was rated by the alumni with moderate satisfaction, while a third of the respondents claimed it excellent, another third opined it very good. While 19.52 percentage of the respondents were hopeful about it, 4.78 percentage felt it average and 1.20 percentage marked it poor.


Regarding the global relevance of the syllabus, almost half of the respondents felt it very good while around one third of the respondents found it excellent. While a quarter of the alumni were positive about it, only a few felt it average and poor.

Answering the innovative potential of the curriculum, one third each of the respondents felt it excellent and very good while a quarter of the alumni were hopeful about it. Barely five percentage of the alumni opined it average and below two percentage of them marked it as poor.

Judging the connection of the syllabus with its skill oriented human development 29.48 percentage of the alumni thought it excellent while 34.66 percentage felt it very good with 27.49 percentage marking it good and 6.77 percentage average and 1.59 percentage poor respectively.

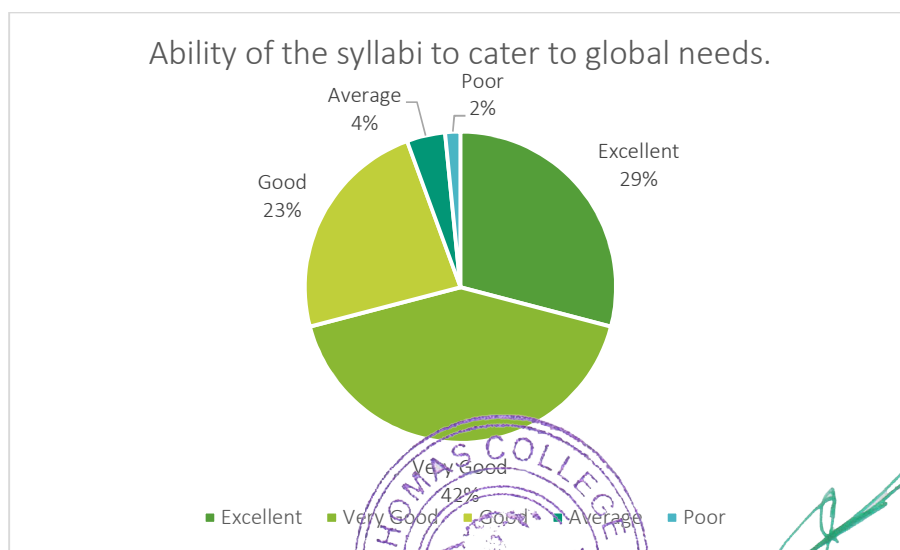
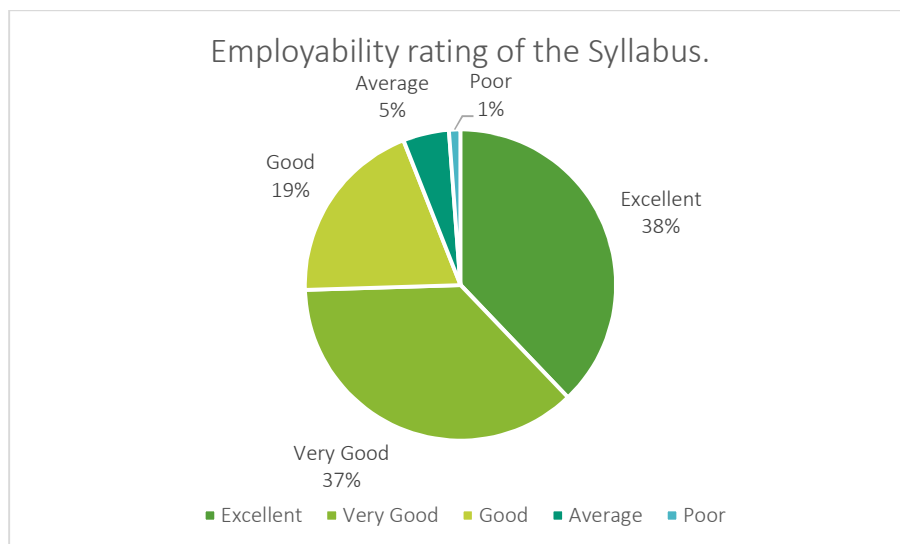
In addressing the efficacy of the syllabus in clearing competitive exams, one third of the respondents each felt it excellent and very good respectively while around one fifth of them marked it good and only a few of the alumni felt it average and poor.

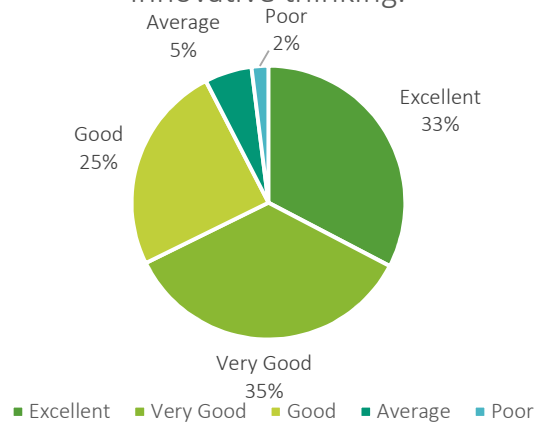

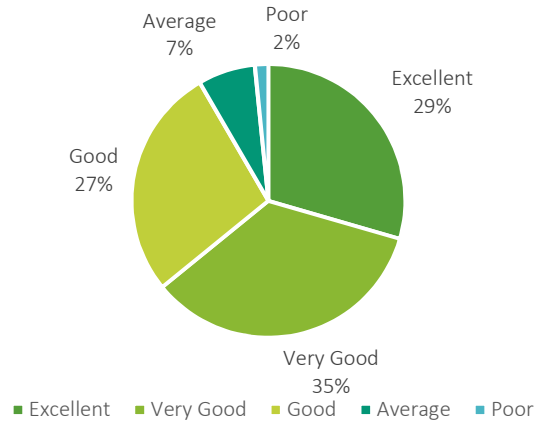


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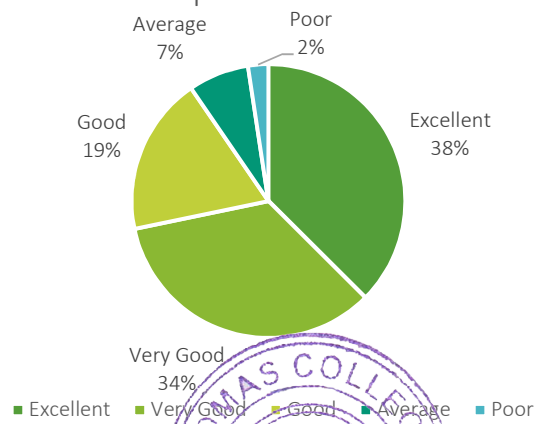
Effectiveness of the curriculum in developing innovative thinking.

Extent to which the syllabus helps to qualify competitive Exams.



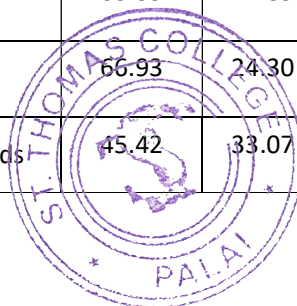

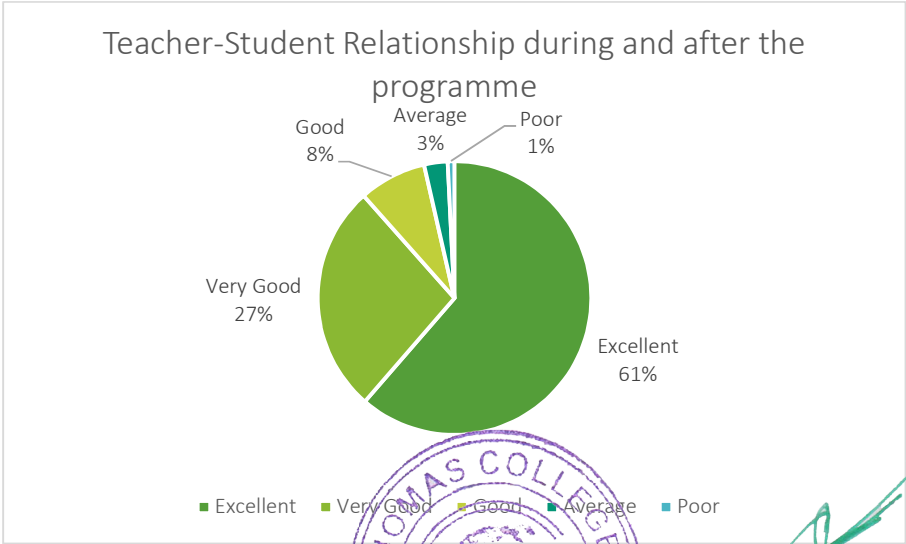
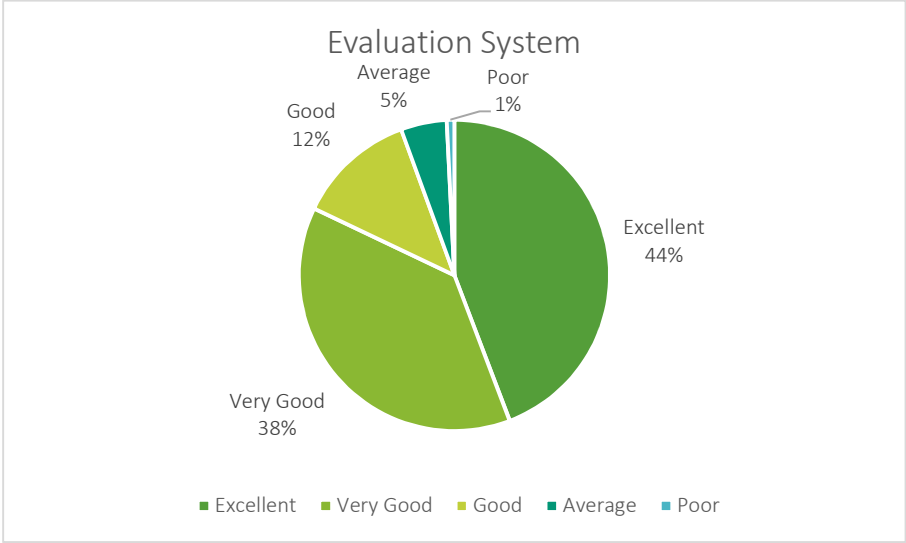
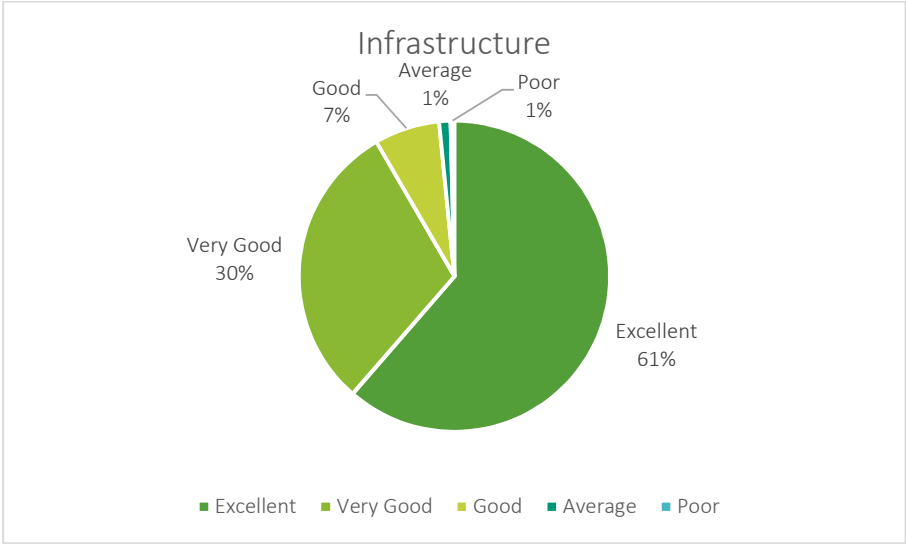
Along with the syllabus feedback, the alumni also expressed their opinion on general aspects pivoting on ten key points. The infrastructure of the college was felt to be excellent by most of the alumni. The respondents had varying opinions about the evaluation system, still only a few felt it average or poor. The feedback on teacher- student relationship clearly showed that the majority of the alumni were very happy about it. The feedback on Career placement and counselling expressed from the respondent's side a requirement for more attention. The alumni expressed themselves fairly happy about the grievance redressal mechanism of the college. While the institution was rated excellently the programmes that the alumni underwent in the institution were not equally rated. The feedback very clearly expressed the eagerness of the alumni to revisit their alma mater. The response of the alumni also pointed to an active network among them.

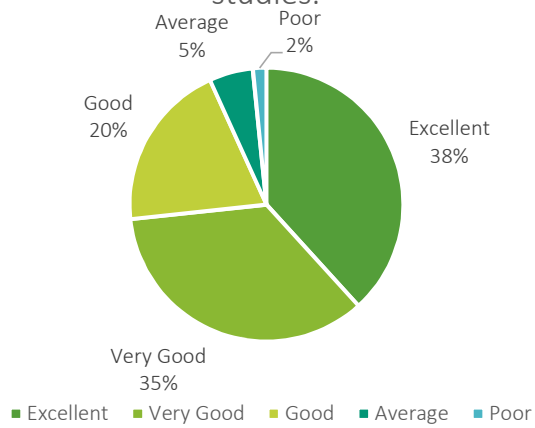


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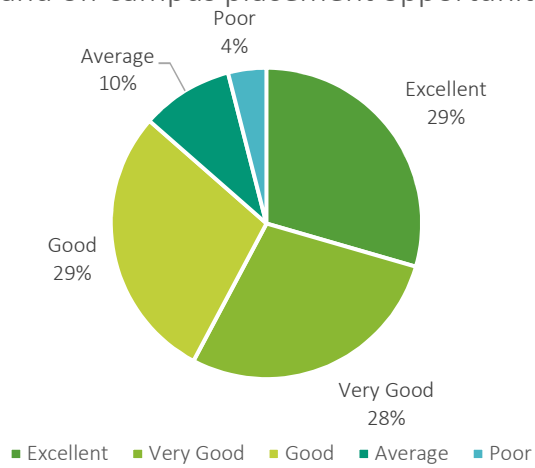


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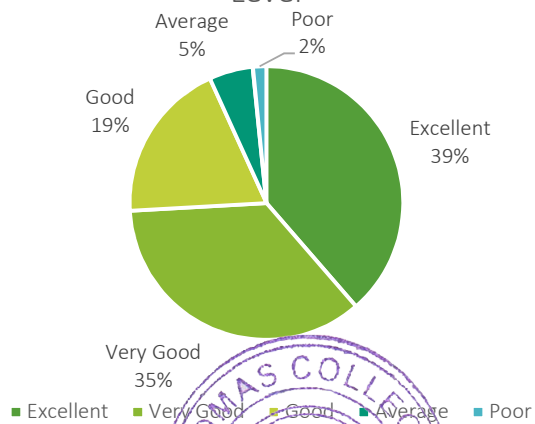

On and off campus placement opportunities.

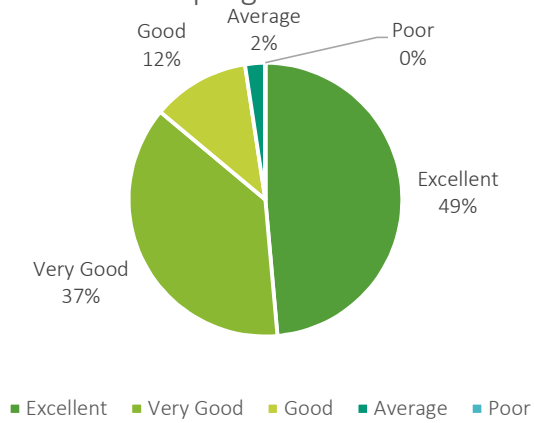


Grievance redressal at the Department/College Level

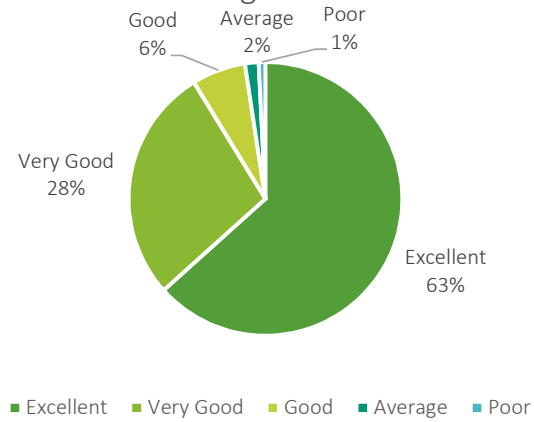


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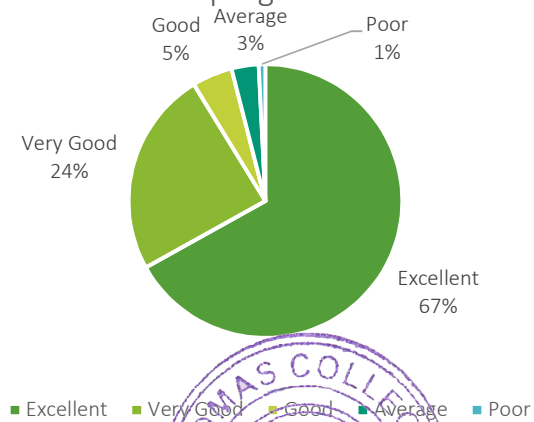
How do you rate the programme after completion of programme?



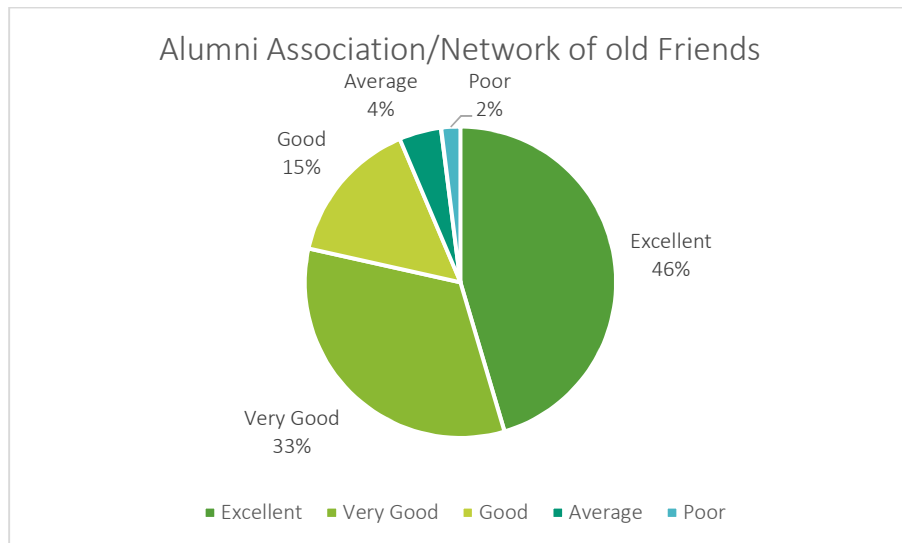
How do you rate the institution after completion of Programme?
